Background

The OHM BDX system, while designed for the ubiquitous browser, is strictly for the Intranet (internal) user. Inside the safe confines of the office network, office and factory personnel alike can access and update the Bedding information to run the factory. As a user logs into the system, he/she gets his own space. Limited only by security rules, users can access and update information in many areas of the business. The system itself is protected from the world outside.

Since all the information is protected, customer service is provided via telephone, email, fax, mail etc. during business hours.

Internet Access

The main objective is to allow authorized customers (dealers) access to specific data in the system using the Internet. The authorized customer, having been assigned a user id and a password, signs on to the system using the internet. The customer can view his/her order and account status, learn about his past purchases, and place new orders for allowed products. He can do this any time allowing us to provide 24X7 service.

Each user id gets a cart to place products. This cart stays active until cleared by the user itself. Thus, a user can login, start an order, add items to the cart and sign out. When he logs back in, his items stay in the cart. At some point, he checks out, thus, confirming the sales order. A web order added by the dealer to the mattress maker is coded as "unapproved". The factory customer service personnel can view all web orders and release them for production.

Setup Internet Access

If you don't already have a website, the first step is to have a company website for the world to see you. A sample web page is shown below.


You will work with your local ISP (internet service provider) who hosts all your web pages. All the information is with the ISP far away from your company.

When your customer clicks the "Dealers" link, it takes him/her to a different web page that is hosted by you. This requires that you acquire a static (fixed) internet protocol (ip) address from your ISP. From that point on, your customer is scanning web pages in a computer that is at your company. This computer is not the same as the one which holds all your data.

This static ip address computer (usually placed in a closet and forgotten about) is a small server style computer that is directly connected to the internet, but not to all computers in your network. This system is referred to as the Middleware, and OHM's web software resides in this computer, and directs information from this machine to the system that holds your business data. The connection is a Remote Call Procedure (RPC) and prevents any hacker from seeing your network.

When your customer clicks the "Dealers" link on your web page, a login page from the Middleware is presented for the customer to enter a user id and a password. A sample login screen is shown below:





The web page above is only a sample. OHM works with you to develop the above web page, and subsequent web pages (shown later in this document). Each web page has to be custom designed to reflect your company's colors, motif and content.

Setup Customer User ID and Password

Each customer whom you wish to access your system must be assigned a user id and a password. The user id need not be the same as the customer id. All the system requires is that you relate an internet user id to an internal customer id. In a similar manner, you can tie a specific store (customer ship to) to an internet user id. This information should be passed on to him via email. He will also be provided the URL for your company web site.


This process can be expanded so that sales reps and employees can also use the internet to gain access to your system.

Customer Home Page


After a successful login by your customer, he is presented with a home page and a menu as shown below


(OHM works with you for the placement of images throughtout your web pages. It is your responsibility to prepare the needed images).

Your customer navigates through the system by clicking on any of the menu items.

Internet Order Entry

While the order entry process is generic, it must appear to be specific for each customer. Your customer must be presented with products that he can buy and nothing else. The products menu presented to your customer uses standard and customer price lists to collect the list of products for the internet customer. The first order entry home page appears as shown below:




While you may produce over 200 types of mattresses and bases, this particular customer may be allowed to buy only the five (5) products shown above. The CRMBDX system determines the products "on the fly" using the customer's active price lists. Products such as Bed Frames and Pillows are allowed to be sold for all customers, and therefore appear for everyone.

To add a product to the cart, the user either clicks the picture or the link with the product name. For example, to buy a Walnut Crest Super bed, the user clicks the link.

Ordering One Product at a time


The internet user may click on the Product Name link, or the picture to order a product one at a time. He selects the bed type, and the size with an option to calculate the price. If for any reason the selected product is not available, he will be notified with a message that "the selected product is not available at this time".

He may also add itemized instructions for the pieces ordered so that each piece can be tagged to a specific end customer. In the example below, the user has selected a queen size mattress, and tagged 2 of the 3 pieces to his consumers.




To finalize the selection, he clicks the "Add to Cart" button.

The next screen confirms the selection. The user may continue shopping, or check out the order at any time.



Ordering all allowed products in a grid format


A faster way for the dealer to order products is to click the My Products link.



The above screen allows the customer to see all his products by bed type and size. He simply fills in the quantities required as shown above. When he clicks "Update Order", all products are added to his cart.

Viewing Cart

At any time, the user can click the cart image to see all items in his cart as shown below.



Notice, the cart shows all products selected with an option to edit or delete line items. He may also click the image icon to view the product.


After viewing the cart, the user may continue shopping. He also has other choices:

- Check out All done, ready to enter final pieces of information
- Empty Cart Start all over
- Print Cart Print contents on paper (shown page 11)



Check Out Process

Check out is a two step process. First the user fills in key information such as who placed the order, purchase order (or reference) number, ship to information (where applicable) and instructions.



When the user clicks the "proceed next" link (not shown), the next step (see page13) appears for the user to reconfirm all the information.




After the user confirms the order (again), the order is updated and the user is shown the screen below.
